Dear Mr. Thompson

I believe that you are misinterpreting our communication. We are not asking the court's permission nor do we have a desire to have a dialog with the County District attorney, at this time. The people "ordained" the Constitution for its government, therefore the court and the County District Attorney are under the peoples exclusive control and not the other way around. We strongly suggest that you read United States -v- Williams [112 S.Ct. 1735, 504 U.S. 36, 118 L.Ed.2d 352] on this matter.

The reason for our filing with the court is to make the court aware that the people of Dutchess County constituted a Grand Jury, and we expect that the document be filed with the court for a memorial.

Our cover letter clearly requested that you direct us to the custodian so we can gain access to the Grand Jury Room in the people's building, as Justice Antonin Scalia said in United States -v- Williams "the Grand Jury should operate in the courthouse under judicial auspices".

We expect a response by fax or phone within 48 hours, giving the name and phone number of the custodian that will give us access to the Grand Jury's room, in the people's courthouse.
